Interdisciplinary Learning:

This term we have a very exciting Interdisciplinary Learning focus planned with P3/2 and LU 3/2. Through social studies, RME, expressive arts and technologies we will be learning lots about the Vikings and developing our skills for learning, life and work as a result.

Listening and Talking: This term, we will be focusing on listening and talking skills and will be learning to ask and answer questions and respond to what we have heard.

Spelling: This term we are continuing with our active literacy approach and will continue learning one phoneme a week.

Numeracy and Maths:
