Laura opened the meeting by welcoming everyone and thanking them for coming.

Correspondance

Lisa advised there have been a few items received;

- ➤ We have received the hall let confirmation for the rest of the school year, for the planned face to face meetings. If any of the online Teams meetings change to face to face, then a new request will need to be submitted with as much notice as possible.
- Ross Lambie emailed about the road markings, following the discussions at the AGM meeting. He had received a response from the council to state that the completion of the markings had been delayed due to adverse weather, and that the work was due to be completed in the next few weeks. We can note that this has since been completed, and we hope it will make a difference to drivers in the area.
- Evelyn Swan from the Gala day council has been in touch and wishes to attend one of our meetings to discuss the role of the gala day within the community. Treasurer's report

Drawstring bags

Mrs Bennie asked if it might be considered that we possibly provide drawstring bags for the children to carry their juice and snack, when they are going to Forest School etc. It can be difficult getting a whole class of juice bottles in carrier bags up to the forest area, so it might be an idea to have individual bags that the children could easily carry themselves.

Parent Council Support

➤ The dwindling numbers at meetings and low parent interaction with the parent council are becoming a worry. We need to try and think of ways to encourage more interaction from parents, and try to get more support and improved attendance at meetings. The newest attendee at the meetings is a P4 parent, so we need to try and gain some support from the lower end of the school.
