Congratulations to Miss Meldrum who welcomed baby Lewis into her family in December. We were all very excited to meet him yesterday when she came to visit.


## Term 3

## **School Improvement Priorities**

## **Writing**

We continue to focus on writing as part of our school improvement this session. We were fortunate to have a second visit from Stephen Graham, a professional development literacy consultant from Australia on January 11<sup>th</sup>. He was very impressed with the high standard of writing that he saw in learners' writing jotters and when working with learners during his visit. Primary 4/3, Primary 5 and Primary 6 classes worked with Mr Graham with teachers from across the school observing his lessons on exposition (to persuade the reader by giving one side of argument)





#### Young Leaders of Learning

Our Rights Ambassadors in school, Harry (P6) Razan (P6) Ruby (P6) and Murray (P5) are raising awareness of children's rights. They are leading a whole school assembly on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January to share the importance of universal rights for all and aim to recruit ambassadors from P3-P6 to join their leadership team.

One of their most recent jobs was to help Miss Lothian appoint Young Leaders of Learning (YLL) They reviewed application forms from learners in Primary 4 and 5 who were interested in this new role and after discussing the skills of the applicants who applied, they appointed 8 YLL.

The YLL team attended a training day at SLC HQ in Hamilton on Wednesday morning to learn about their role and are very excited to take this initiative forward.

# **Cross Country**
