Literacy and Numeracy

Providing a rich and stimulating curriculum that helps raise standards in literacy and numeracy.

- Continue to develop play and enquirybased pedagogies within Literacy with a strategic focus on Reading and a maintenance review of writing
- Continue to develop our reading profile to maintain Reading School – Gold Status and refresh our school library
- Continue to develop enquiry -based pedagogy within Numeracy with a continued focus on staff development
- Continue to develop early language and communication skills through purposeful play opportunities, with refreshed trackers.
- Re- establish family learning opportunities to engaged parents'/carers





At Blackwood Primary and ELC we will focus on several improvements to support all our learners taking account of National and SLC priorities.

Health and Wellbeing and Sustainability

- Establish small group interventions to support learners including Nurture
